


## GOAT FEEDING GUIDE

## HAY CUBES AS A FORAGE REPLACEMENT

Timothy Alfalfa Cubes & Alfalfa Cubes (lbs/day)

Maintenance	3	
Lactation Dairy	6.6	
Lactation non-Dairy	3.3	
Grower	2.2	



- Grower diet is from birth to breeding
- Hay cubes must be fed a minimum of 2x/day as a complete hay replacement



Dehydrated Alfalfa Pellets (lbs/day)

Maintenance	0.6	0.8	-
Breeding	0.8-1	0.9-1.1	-
Early Gestation	1	-	-
Late Gestation	0.7-0.85	-	-
Early Lactation	1.4-3.4	-	-
Mid Lactation	1.3-2.9	-	-
Late Lactation	0.9-3	-	-
Starter	_	_	0.5
Grower	-	_	0.8
Finisher	_	_	0.1



- Recommended portions only, individual results may vary
- To be fed with long stem forage as a part of a complete balanced feeding ration
- Pellets can not replace hay completely
- Dairy animals require higher feeding rate than meat animals
